WANT TO KNOW HOW TO FIND REPUBLICANS IN YOUR PRECINCT?
HERE'S HOW!

STEP ONE: CREATE AN ACCOUNT

Set up an account by completing form and emailing to info@elections.ok.gov (you'll get your login in 1 business day or less)

STEP TWO: DOWNLOAD VOTER DATA

1. Login
2. Custom Query - Submit Custom Query
3. Voter information, hit CONTINUE
4. By County / Registration and History / Type in Description (whatever you want to call it), hit CONTINUE
5. Select Washington County, make sure "all precincts" is checked, hit CONTINUE
6. Add "Voter History Election Date" "Is Between" "01/14/2020" "12/12/2023", hit CONTINUE
7. "Yes"
8. Custom Queries - View Custom Queries Results - Download file

STEP THREE: FIND 4X4 VOTERS

To edit the voter spreadsheet:

1. Open in spreadsheet software. If you want just your precinct, sort by Precinct, delete all other precincts
2. Sort by Status - delete "I" (inactive voters)
3. Sort by PolitalAff - delete all parties except Republican
4. Sort by VoterHist1 - delete all blanks
5. Repeat Step 4 for rest of Voter History columns in numerical order (2, 3, etc)

STEP FOUR: CREATE A WALK LIST

To create a walk list:

1. Sort by (in order) - (*complete sort for each one before the next sort*):
 - Precinct
 - StreetName
 - StreetType
 - StreetDir
 - StreetNum
